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## The Little School That Could!

THIS COMING WEEKEND is very special to those who grew up on the Island during the 1960s. They'll be celebrating the 40th Reunion of former students and staff of the St. Joseph Island District High School with a two-day dinner and dance extravaganza on Friday and Saturday.

If you didn't grow up here, you might not even know that the island once had its own tiny, four room high school, tucked away on a quiet side street in Richards Landing. And the story reminds us of the classic "Little Engine That Could".

By 'normal' standards, the St. Joseph Island District High School had a short life – opened in 1960 and closed a mere 12 years later, in 1972. But SJIDHS wasn't 'normal', and in those 12 short years, it helped to mould the minds, ideas and character of an entire generation of young islanders – many of whom are now the driving force behind the island's economy and sense of community.

But the little school almost didn't even get a chance to exist, and its story provides yet another wonderful example of the kind of community and people amongst whom we live.

Perhaps it's because it was the early '60s, with "the people" standing together against "the establishment" to bring the community what it needed. After years of being held up in red tape by the Ontario Municipal Board and the Department of Education, the St. Joseph Township Council went

ahead on its own with building and financing the badly-needed school, at a cost of \$76,000.

When the construction bills exceeded the available funds and the project was in dire danger of collapsing in ruins, a group of concerned citizens stepped up together to provide the security to obtain a bank loan, not once but twice! While the bureaucracy slowly ground along, "the people" MADE it happen! Eventually, the necessary approvals were received and SJIDHS opened its doors for the 1960 academic year. Even then, it was something just a little different from 'main-stream' schools.

"Education is not the pouring of jelly into a mold" said Reverend Ken Robinson in his Commencement Remarks to the 1964 graduating class. "It is the aid given you to develop the abilities you have." That attitude reflects the standards set right from the beginning, and it sure seemed to work. SJIDHS graduates appeared to do better than 'average' when they moved on to higher education or out into the workplace.

Perhaps that was due to the atmosphere that the school fostered. Since it was small and chronically under-equipped, the faculty and students had to have a well-developed sense of ingenuity. Widely loved and respected (and perhaps still feared!) teacher Ches Wallace still lives just down the street from the former school. In a 1972 interview with a Toronto Star reporter, Mr. Wallace cited one example. "The students

didn't run out and buy a new flagpole when the one in front of the school bent. They went out and **fixed** it!"

Similar stories abound about how the students pitched in to keep their school running. "When the school's drainage system was plugged, the senior students dug it up and fixed it," said teacher Mrs. Josephine Wilson. Perhaps things were a little simpler on a smaller scale. Mr. Richard White commented that the smaller, simpler environment "lets him take students on outings at a moment's notice. Three cars will take the whole class nicely."

Then there are the stories of Mr. Wallace taking classes on "jaunts in the winter countryside on snowmobiles" – all things that you'd probably never dream of in these 'modern' times. Imagine a school where the piano bangs away to tunes all through lunch hour, where Grade 12 students cook lunch on the tiny laboratory's Bunsen burner and where virtually every student knows every other student.

The students also had a great idea for raising money for a good cause, the "Circum Insulam", an annual around-the-island chariot race. The 'Roman' connection was no accident. Unlike many other Ontario schools of the time, Latin and French studies were compulsory for SJIDHS Grades 9 and 10. Why are we not surprised to learn that?

Eventually though, time ran out for the dynamic, 'different' little school. The Age of Aquarius petered out and, by the turn of the 1970s, economics prevailed and the little community high school simply could not compete with more financially viable, centralized education. The school was closed and the student body was amalgamated into the newly-built Central Algoma Secondary School (CASS) in nearby Desbarats.

The former high school, located at 1669 Arthur Street in Richards Landing, now serves the people of St. Joseph Township as their Municipal Offices. It's fitting that the building at least, should continue on as the home of the local government of "the people" by "the people".

And sometimes, on a still, quiet afternoon, you'd swear that you could still hear the echoes of that piano playing!
