## 548 To Return To Gravel Surface

Stony Roadson from the Canadian Ministry of Cars and Boats (CMCB) was on hand this past weekend to inform the public of the new transition, coming later this summer. Assuming of course summer comes. With nothing but snow in the long-term forecast, we may get to keep our paved highway until July.

“We can no longer provide the upkeep for highway 548 in St. Joseph island. All our workers have come down with cases of Odocoileusophobia. Simply put; they’re terrified of deer. Once they found out deer outnumber people on the island, everyone refused to work. It makes more sense to tear the road up and pour gravel than to send our team out there. We may not see them again.”

Reports are still coming in, but Yukon Cornelius from the Ministry of Weird Diseases (MWD) has shared with the Clippings the possibility of an outbreak of an unknown disease affecting these workers, which is the cause for the intense fear of deer. As of now the disease seems to only affect road workers and Mr. Cornelius assured us that his team is on top of the disease and the research should be



available around April 1st of 2019.

With gravel coming, the speed limits will be reduced from 80km down to 30km. This will keep gravel from falling off the road into the ditch and prevent accidents.

## Creature Feature

### Sasquatch - Big Foot



Big Foot was first talked about way back in Island Clippings Issue#1032 when “Finding Bigfoot” was filmed on the Island back before our time here. The article (available here [http://islandclippings.com/issues/issue\\_1032.pdf](http://islandclippings.com/issues/issue_1032.pdf)) mentions a sighting in Hilton Beach way back in 2007.

Sasquatches are found in forested region which is the perfect spot for their main source of food: deer. They are nocturnal, which makes them hard to spot and here on the island their numbers are unknown because they have such little impact on the environment around here. It is suggested that they are monogamous, having one or two babies per year however the actual length of their lifespan is unknown.

Sasquatches are found in 40 states and six countries, but the varied landscape of St. Joseph Island makes it the perfect habitat for these apes. Another reason the island is perfect for Big Foot is that they have a sweet tooth for maple syrup.

April is prime sasquatch spotting season, so be sure to keep an ear out for their low grumbles or their giant foot prints through the mud.

“Ideally people will drive slower” says Roadson, since he doesn’t anticipate additional gravel being brought over for at least 7 years, shortly after he retires from his cushy job at the CMCB.

So when should we expect the new gravel roads? “As soon as the ground thaws, preferably, whenever that will be,” says Roadson. “The bulldozers will come in that we’ve borrowed from southern Ontario, and the construction will commence starting at Mom’s restaurant. Workers from down south seem to have an immunity to the fear of deer, so there shouldn’t be a problem.” Roadson and his team plan to have the gravel shipped in as soon as May. The leftover pavement to be dug up from the roads has been sold to China.

While gravel may seem like a step back, this isn’t ordinary gravel but a special blend that even includes a new mineral taken from a meteor that allegedly works well in the snow and is easy on the tires. The gravel blend is completely untested, but HWY 548 was chosen from a list of at least 3 or 4 highways across Canada for testing.

“Pavement is the past, and gravel is the future” Roadson calmly boasts. At this point several deer ran down the Huron Line and Stony was unable to complete the interview.

We look forward to trying this new gravel out for ourselves.

pressed gratitude for the digital x-ray as it brings the Richards Landing – Matthews site diagnostic imaging capabilities to current best practices. Kim Roussele, NSHN – Diagnostic Imaging Manager and Jonathon Vairo, NSHN – X-ray Technologist enthu-

siastically described the improvements provided by the new portable digital x-ray, as compared to CR (computed radiography) which uses a cassette and digitizer for processing. Improved features include: fast, high quality images, the digital images can be viewed in seconds on the screen instead of minutes due to processing, and lower radiation doses. Images are transferred by Wi-Fi to Radiologists in Sudbury and the digital machine is mobile for transporting to the critically ill/injured patient.

The NSHN Richards Landing – Matthews Site is the first of the NSHN sites to receive this updated equipment. Fundraising has begun for digital x-ray machines for the other two NSHN sites in Thessalon and Blind River; the estimated cost for this equipment is a minimum of \$260,000 per site. The NSHN Thessalon site is scheduled to receive this upgrade in approximately one year and the NSHN Blind River site in two years.

The North Shore Health Network Foundation and the NSHN Auxiliaries appreciate the support received for each site through gifts from individuals, families and businesses, as well as their support of fundraising events. All funds are directed to the site specified by the donors and help fund essential medical equipment and patient services. Medical equipment costs are not covered by the Ministry of Health which is why the NSHN Foundation and the NSHN Auxiliary groups are constantly working to meet ongoing needs in our communities.

## Recipe Corner

### April Fool's Cake

This cake looks like a sweet dessert but is actually a savory dish.

#### Ingredients

- 1 jar (14 ounces) pizza sauce
- 1/2 pound Johnsonville® Ground Mild Italian sausage, cooked and crumbled
- 1 package (8 ounces) sliced pepperoni
- 3 cups biscuit/baking mix
- 3/4 cup whole milk
- 2 large eggs
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt
- 5 to 6 slices mozzarella cheese

#### Directions

1. In a bowl, combine the pizza sauce, sausage and pepperoni; set aside. In another bowl, combine the biscuit mix, milk, eggs, butter and garlic salt. Spread half of the batter on the bottom and up the sides of a greased 10-in. fluted tube pan. Spoon



meat mixture over batter; cover with remaining batter.

2. Bake at 375° for 35-40 minutes or until browned and a toothpick comes out clean. Invert onto a baking sheet. Arrange cheese over cake. Return to the oven for 5 minutes or until cheese is melted. Serve immediately.

#### Ingredients

- 1 pint vanilla ice cream
- 1 (1 ounce) envelope instant cocoa
- 4 tablespoons sweetened whipped cream

#### Directions

Scoop out 4 balls of ice cream roughly the size and shape of small potatoes. Roll in the hot cocoa mix until coated. Place on a plate and top with a dollop of whipped cream. The ice cream will look like baked potatoes with sour cream on top. Eat and enjoy.
