## Roller Derby in Northern Ontario

WITH THE THAW OF WINTER and the spring into spring, the heat sure is being felt in the arenas across Ontario as Roller Derby season has started again!

Sault Roller Derby has been hard at work this winter, training its team and recruiting ‘fresh meat’. After a long wait and a lot of hard work ‘Soonami Slammers’ were ready to play their first bout of the year last April, when the team travelled to Cochrane, Ontario to play their team,

the 'Cochrane Derby Gurlz'.

The Derby Gurlz have a reputation of being a strong and together team. The Slammers were ready to take the hits they were given and send some slams of their own. The Derby Gurlz were able to play a very strong defensive game and keep the Slammers jammer from scoring points, winning the game 177-109. The bout was recorded and put onto Youtube. Simply search Cochrane Derby Gurlz vs. Sault Ste. Marie to see more.

There is a lot of training required before you can play in a bout. Skaters have to pass a minimum skills test that ensures she can skate, recover, balance, be agile, and knows how to react in game play. All of us take our skills test before the season starts, so we know we are capable of being on the track and learn what we need to work on.

It takes each skater a different amount of time to be ready to play. Sault Roller Derby works their practices so every level of skater can participate and have fun. There is a lot of endurance and strength training involved in our practices. We are also always working on our skating skills. Stopping is the trickiest bit to get good at, but when you can control your speed and feet, you can then apply those skills to attacking your opponent.

In practices we will usually talk about a certain play that we want to use and then divide into different skill groups and practice the concept.

There is a lot of strategy involved in the sport. For example: Once you hit an opponent out of bounds, she has to return behind you. We use this rule to practice hitting a jammer out of bounds and then skating as far back as possible with your team. This is advantageous because she now has to recover half a track before she can try to score more points.

We are excited to be involved in a regional league where so much opportunity to play is made for everyone.

NORD is a regional league of roller derby chapters who work together to foster the growth sustainability of the sport of roller derby in Northern Ontario. Its chapters include Kirkland Lake, Timmins, Sudbury, Sault Ste. Marie, Temiskaming Area, Cochrane and Thunder Bay.

Each chapter takes turns hosting events where skaters get the opportunity to play with other teams. It is common for a chapter to host a scrimmage where all skaters show up and are divided in no particular order and play 2 20 minutes periods for fun. There are also several scheduled bouts between chapters this year where skaters will play on their rostered home team. These events are always well sought after because sometimes a guest coach will be brought in to lead a boot

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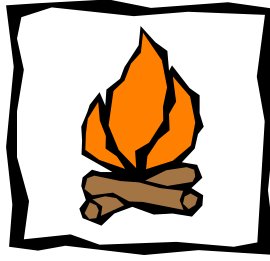


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- You **MUST** obtain a Fire Permit **PRIOR** to burning during the period April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> (Permits are issued at each Municipal Office)
- **NO DAYTIME BURNING** – check with your Municipal Office for specific time restrictions
- Use extreme caution when conditions are dry or windy: **DO NOT BURN** if winds are over 16 km/hr (10 miles per hour)
- Keep the size of your brush piles manageable: a single pile should be less than 2 metres (6 feet) in diameter and less than 2 metres (6 feet) high
- Costs – if it is determined you have not complied with the conditions of the fire permit you will be guilty of an offence under the Forest Fire Prevention Act, and/or the Ontario Fire Code, and/or the Environmental Protection Act and upon conviction subject to a fine or imprisonment as provided in the said legislation.
- Read the conditions on your Burning Permit. **Ask questions if you are not sure.** When you sign for your permit you are acknowledging that you read, understand and accept the terms and responsibilities.

There is **NO CHARGE** for a burning permit.

camp and roller skate vendors usually make an appearance too.

There are 3 teams in NORD that include skaters from each chapter.

‘NORD Starz’ are the travelling A team. There are 2 skaters from Sault Ste. Marie on the roster this year. “KT KaBOOM” and “Gruesome Gracie” have finished their ‘fresh meat’ year and are now looking for more competitive play. Sault Roller Derby’s “DevilZone” and “B czar” are legends of NORD Starz and always have a place on this team.

The ‘Starz’ started their season April 16th in Thunder Bay, where they bouted against the newly appointed WFTDA-ranked team, ‘The Babes of Thunder.’ It was a hard fought bout the entire match. The Starz were doing a great job of scoring points of their own, but the Babes were able to control the speed of the pack and stop the Starz defences to take the win in their first bout of the year with a score of 161 to 127!

It was a great amount of fun and we look forward to playing them again. Next for the NORD Starz is a bout against Windsor’s ‘Boarder City Brawlers All Stars’ in Windsor May 21st and a home bout in Sudbury against Wellington’s Feims on September 10th.

‘NEO Fights’ is a team of skaters who are in their first year of boutting aka “Fresh Meat”. Each league trains about 2-3 fresh

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meat skaters a year. Together the NEO Fights get to practice twice before they go to Toronto's Fresh and the Furious tournament on July 9th. This tournament is just for skaters who passed their Minimum Skills test within the past year. Teams come in from all over Ontario and Quebec to get this opportunity to play their hardest against people in their same skill level.

Sault Roller Derby has recruited 3 new skaters this year who are still aiming to pass their skills test. "Lil Ass Kicker" and "Bitch B Trippin'" have been skating with Soonami Slammers for the past year and are now able to join our rookie team!! They will meet the rest of the team June 4th for Timmins' "Doom in June" event.

**Thoughts from the New Kid on the Block**

I have spent three-quarters of my life in this province but only recently discovered the jewel known as St. Joseph's Island. I am finding the plethora of trees, the fresh air, and the friendly, down-to-earth folks to be a delight but a couple of things have struck me as needing a mention.

As an avid environmentalist, I am dismayed when I walk the trails to see broken beer bottles, cans, and other garbage strewn on the forest floor. If you bring it into the bush, please have enough care for Mother Earth and other nature-lovers to take your garbage home with you. And while you are at it, why not pick up any other garbage that you see? If we all do our bit, we will all benefit.

As well, it saddens me to see such deep ruts on some of the trails that I would hesitate to drive my Jimmy 4X4 along them. It just makes sense to avoid driving into the bush after heavy rains. If you do leave ruts that would prevent the passage of other vehicles then please return at a later date with gravel and a rake or shovel to repair the damage. Please treat the bush with the same care and respect as your own back yard. Your friends and neighbours will thank you for it.

I was thrilled to discover that two of the island dumps have free stores. The benefits are two-fold. It reduces the amount of land-fill and helps people on low income who might not otherwise be able to afford lumber, appliances, and more. On the down-side, I am wondering why there is no free store at the third site? Picking is no longer allowed and many usable and/or repairable items are being needlessly discarded. As a young senior on a disability pension, it saddens me to hear people say how dependent they have been on items found at the dump and then for me to see lumber which could be used for shelving, tires still with usable tread, and so much more, on refuse piles. Surely there could be signs posted: "Remove items at your own risk" or "We assume no responsibility for injuries sustained during the removal of items"? You get the idea.

The other concern I have about the dumps is the fees. Not everyone can afford the dumping fees and I have observed, in other communities in which I have resided, that the levying of such fees promotes illegal dumping, often into the bush. I suggest that fees should be on a sliding scale for medical pensioners, impoverished seniors, or social assistant recipients. People should not be forced to choose between being able to afford food and other necessities of life, or disposing of waste in an environmentally responsible manner.

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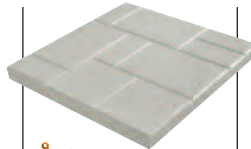

## Mike Mantha Tells Government "No Cuts at MMH"

DURING THE MAY 10TH QUESTION PERIOD of the Ontario Legislature, Michael Mantha, MPP for Algoma-Manitoulin, demanded the Wynne government provide assurances to patients and families that there will be no cuts to the Matthews Memorial Hospital as a result of health care underfunding.

"I've heard from St. Joseph Island, Desbarats, Bruce Mines, the North Shore and other surrounding areas about how devastating this would be to our communities. Patients and families deserve to know what's happening to our local hospital." "Will the Minister tell us exactly what cuts are on the table at Matthews Memorial Hospital?" Mantha said.

Mantha said the Wynne Liberals are leaving Northern health care behind. "Funding for hospitals in Northern Ontario is simply inadequate," Mantha said. "And to make matters worse, small Northern hospitals do not have the funding to offer out-patient lab work. We have seen time and time again that Northern patients are taking a backseat when it comes to proper health care."

"Why is this government refusing to deliver the stable, predictable funding that hospitals need to protect patient care for the people of Northern Ontario?" he asked.

Although we reported in our May 5th issue that the Board of Trustees of the Blind River District Health Centre had taken cuts to MMH hours "off the table", there still has been, at least to our knowledge, no official confirmation received of that fact.

Until Ontario's healthcare underfunding issues are resolved once and for all, we can never let down our guard against such draconian austerity measures that threaten the health and wellbeing of the people who pay for it all.
