Sylvan Circle Tour



The 19th Annual Sylvan Circle tour was this past Saturday.

In total, sixty six Artisans were featured on the approximately 100km route where community halls and studios from Echo Bay to Bruce Mines and back around again showcased their works. While there were no actual stops on St. Joseph Island and we generally stick to covering events that happen on the Island, several of the artisans featured on the tour are based here.

In past years they have had some artisans from Southern Ontario, but this year everyone fea-

tured is based in Algoma.

Those who wish to participate in showing their art on the tour must first present their work to a committee in April. There is actually a waitlist to get onto the tour as an exhibitor. Everything from photography, both wildlife and landscapes, to paintings, walking sticks,

matreshka dolls, jewelry, pottery and much more.

While there was a threat of rain for the day, it thankfully held off until after the event concluded in the afternoon. With a start time of 9am and ending at 5pm, it turns out if you want to see most of the displays you should plan for it to last the entire full day. Many of the stops were serving food in case some got hungry. Foot traffic varied at each stop and while some locations were quite busy, having



the stops spaced out and open the entire day, it was busy without being too packed.

In past years, the estimates for attendance has been 1500, while it's difficult to get a true figure with multiple starting and stopping points, David Solomon, one of the tour organizers, tells us this year's crowd is one of the larger that the tour has seen. He tells us: "Many artists/artisans reported record sales this year and many first year exhibitors were thrilled with their sales and the interaction and feedback from the general public. We also believe that many area businesses received a nice economic spin off from the tour, as we heard about long lineups at some of the local restaurants during the tour. Overall, this year's tour was again a huge success! "

Common Snapping Turtle



Canada's largest freshwater turtle can weigh up to 16kg with an average shell length of 20-36 cm.

These guys can pack a mean bite and are often seen in shallow, muddy waters. We're not sure why this one is crossing the road in late September, but earlier in the year they venture away from the water during nesting season in early to mid summer. Remember to be extra careful if you see them on the road, Snapping Turtles are listed as a species at risk.

A nesting female will be at least 17 years old and lay 40-50 eggs. Depending on the nest's temperature, all the babies will be either male or female. If the temperature is between 23-28°C, all the babies will be male. Any other temperature they will all be female. While it may be tempting to try and help one you encounter on the side of the road, that would not be a good idea as it would be equally dangerous for you and the turtle. While they are not overly aggressive, they do have the ability to amputate fingers should you decide to try and pick one up.

According to the Ontario website, they are primarily found in Southern Ontario with a shrinking range. Still as of late September they have not hibernated yet.

Despite their fierce prehistoric look, about 90% of a snapping turtles diet is dead plant or animal matter. They play an important role in keeping lakes and wetlands clean. Snapping turtles can live upwards of 100 years.
