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55th Annual Maple Syrup Festival Concludes



It is a sure sign spring is fully here, the 55th Annual Maple Syrup festival at the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 374 in Richards Landing has concluded. Both this past weekend and the first weekend saw great weather, unlike 2023.

Just over 2800 people were served during the four day event, which is over 1000 addional people compared to last years record low crowds due to a spring blizard.

Just how much syrup do 2800 people consume? 225 litres of sweet sweet maple syrup that was supplied by Wes Stevens Maple products was poured atop 103 five kilogram boxes of sausages and 280 kilograms of pancakes.

If you wanted even more syrup, there were many vendors selling maple syrups of different varities (amber, dark,



wood fired etc) and other maple products. Additionally, other vendors had handmade crafts and other local products. Everycont on next page

Owl Survey On St. Joseph Island

Wednesday, April 10th was a near perfect night. Skies were clear, winds were calm, temperatures were not too chilly and the spring peepers weren't vet in full chorus. The two men drove across the island, scouting the route and seeing lots of deer and turkeys out in the fields. At their starting point, geese called as they came in to roost on the water for the night. Equipment was checked and then they headed to the first point shown by the GPS. They arrived a half hour after sunset, put out the equipment, pressed play and started listening. Three tones followed by silence, three more tones then more silence, a series of strange calls unlikely to be heard on St. Joe at any other time and then three repetitions of the familiar "Who cooks for you?" barred owl call. The barred owl calls played three more times with periods of silence in between each set. Things weren't looking good at this site where in previous years, owls had come right out to the road side. Finally, after the fourth set of calls,

a response from the north, a real barred owl. Information was recorded on the data sheet, equipment was packed up and the pair headed off to the next site where the whole

REVISED NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF <u>A ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT</u> <u>BY</u> <u>THE CORPORATION OF</u> <u>THE TOWNSHIP OF HILTON</u>

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton, on the 6th day of March, 2024, passed By-Law No. 1407-24 under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect of the by-law by filing <u>no later than 4:00 p.m. on May 8, 2024</u>, a notice of appeal with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton setting out the reasons for the appeal.

Only individuals, corporations, and public bodies may appeal a zoning by-law to the Ontario Land Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group; however, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Land Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

The purpose and effect of this by-law is to amend the municipality's comprehensive zoning by-law to define and regulate short-term residential rental accommodation uses within the municipality. All other provisions of By-law No. 1025-11 continue to apply.

This amendment shall apply to the whole of the Township of Hilton. A copy of the By-law is available for inspection, during our regular office hours, at the Hilton Township Municipal Office, 2983 Base Line Road (Hwy. 548), Hilton Beach. Ontario POR 1G0.





process was repeated.

In all, ten sites were sampled, each about two km apart. Eleven barred owls were heard from, three came right up to the road side. One pair at one of the sites heckled the volunteers relentlessly, sounding more like monkeys than owls. At another site, turkeys gobbled after almost every owl call. And, one curious landowner came out to check and see why two people were loitering around outside of his property at 10:30 at night.

The owl surveys are done by volunteers on behalf of Birds Canada and this was only one of four areas that are surveyed on the island. The surveys are done annually, on calm nights in mid-April when the owls seem most likely to answer recorded calls. Information on weather conditions and owl responses are recorded and submitted to Birds Canada. More information on the surveys can be found on the Birds Canada website https://www.birdscanada.org/bird-science/nocturnal-owl-survey.

So, if it is mid-April and you see a few people standing around a vehicle on the side of the road, stop and listen for a few minutes. Chances are that you'll hear the "Who cooks for you?" call coming from the vehicle. Then, really listen for a response from the real thing. And if you're lucky, you might even see or hear an owl come closer to really check things out.
