Over the 2 weekends 260kg of pancake mix was topped with 600L of maple syrup, along with 405kg of sausages! It's always interesting to us, and hopefully our readers to see just how much syrup, pancakes and sausages are consumed. But while those numbers are impressive, more impressive is how many people it takes to make sure all those people get fed.

When we asked Gloria Ridell at The Legion for the numbers she wanted to make sure all the volunteers got a big shout out. She tells us : "In total there were around 200 four hour shifts over the 4 days. The volunteers were both Legion members as well as non members stepping up. Some even volunteered all 4 days. Without them, this major fundraiser would not be possible.

She goes on to tell us "Community support for our Legion is incredible!" She also wanted to thank everyone who supports all the fundraisers, friday foods and wing nights.

Many, and perhaps most of you reading this, attended the Maple Syrup Festival at The Royal Canadian Legion in Richards Landing over the last 2 weekends. Unless you went at an off peak time, you're aware that thousands of people attended.

While freezing rain and Easter Sunday being on the first Sunday did drop attendance to 865 over the first weekend, things substantially picked up on the second weekend. 952 were served on Saturday alone,
